Finding hope in Jesus...

1. Jesus Is Our Only Hope (vs. 3-4)

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a <u>living hope</u> through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, ⁴ to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,"

"Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." – John 14:6

2. Jesus Is Our Hope in Tough Moments (vs. 6-7)

"In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, ⁷ so that the tested genuineness of your faith—more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ."

"Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, ³ for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. ⁴ And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing." – James 1:2-4

3. Jesus Is Our Living Hope (vs. 8-9)

"Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, ⁹ obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls."
