

Holy Momentum: In Peace
Colossians 3:1-15
June 21, 2020

“Strive for peace with everyone, and for the holiness without which no one will see the Lord.” – Hebrews 12:14

*“Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.”
– 2 Corinthians 5:20*

Steps we can take to have momentum in peace...

1. Peace Comes from A Personal Relationship with God (vs. 1-2)

“If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. ² Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.”

*“For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.”
– Colossians 3:3-4*

2. Peace Comes from Being One in Christ (vs. 9-10)

“Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices ¹⁰ and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.”

“Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free; but Christ is all, and in all. ¹² Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,” – Colossians 3:11-12

3. Peace Comes When We Love Others (vs. 14-15)

“And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. ¹⁵ And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.”
